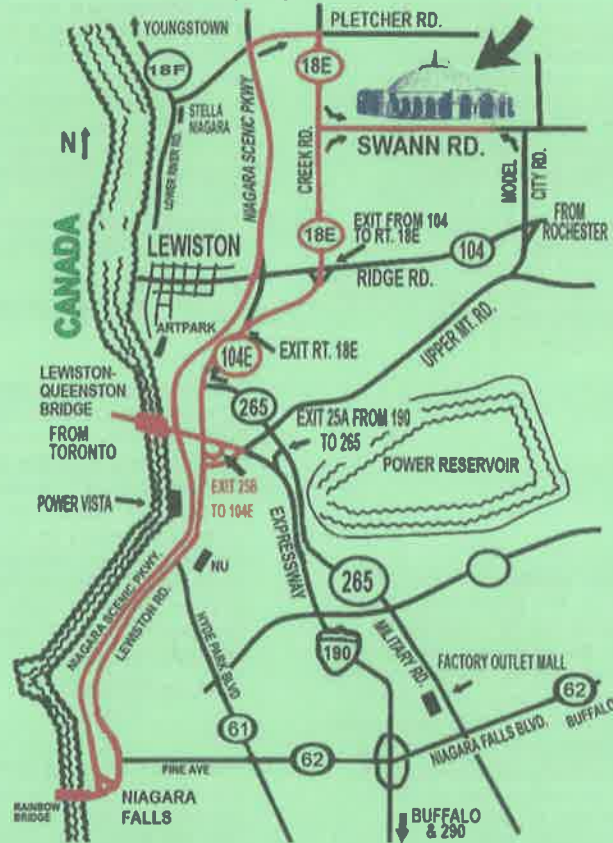

FROM BUFFALO: From Rts. 290 (Youngmann
Highway), 90 & 190- Exit 25A onto Rt. 265 North
(left); then to Rt. 104 East (right); to Rt. 18 East (north);
to right turn onto Swann Rd.

FROM ROCHESTER: From Rt. 31 right onto Rt. 265
North (Military Rd.); right onto Rt. 104 East; to Rt. 18 E
(north); right onto Swann Rd. From Rt 104 left following
signs for Rt 18E and Fatima Shrine; right at stop sign
onto Rt 18 East (north); right onto Swann Rd.

FROM TORONTO: Queen Elizabeth Way to Rt. 405.
Take Lewiston-Queenston Bridge to Exit 25B; to
104 East; to Rt. 18 East (north); right onto Swann Rd.

FROM NIAGARA FALLS: Niagara Scenic Parkway
north to Pletcher Rd. exit; turn right off exit; turn right
onto Creek Rd. (Rt. 18W); turn left onto Swann Rd.
