

Meditation for the 3rd Sunday of Easter Year B

Easter, a time of celebration! We celebrate and remember with joy that Jesus is the fulfillment of God's promise of salvation, and he has come to save us - body and soul. We look forward to the resurrection of the dead and life of the world to come. Therefore our physical and spiritual realities are infused with each other and integrated within creation as the "Imago Dei" - for indeed all creation is made in the image of God."

The Paschal Mystery Is a continuum, the affirmation that Jesus Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, body and soul, by the Father. Now, his glorified body has been seen by the Apostles and many others. It is through Christ and in Christ and with Christ that we will be united with God, our Father and creator, on the last day. Every time as we profess our faith in the Creed, we look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come.

Today's readings amplify our belief in and our commitment to the Resurrection. The Apostle Peter witnesses to the people that Jesus who, was handed over out of ignorance, was raised from the dead in fulfillment of the prophets. The risen Christ stands in our midst even now and asks, "Why are you troubled?" Jesus speaks, "Look at my hands and my feet, so that what you see it is indeed myself."

In the second reading, John exhorts his community of believers *not* to commit sin by keeping God's commandments. Moreover, John's words are encouraging so that the way we may be sure that we know him is to keep in his commandments, the most important of which is love.

In addition to the witness of the empty tomb are the post-resurrection appearances to the disciples. Jesus the author of life eternal was put to death, but God has raised him from the dead. By believing in the risen Christ we acknowledge his presence body, soul, and divinity. In other words, our "yes" to the risen Christ assures us that we know him through the power of God's mercy and love.

When we are in distress in our human condition let us plead along with the psalmist, "Let the light of your countenance shine upon us." God indeed listens to us and answers our prayers. The Lord hears us and has pity on us and invites us to touch and see and believe. Alleluia.
