

Meditation for the 4th Sunday of Easter Year B

The Fourth Sunday of Easter calls us to respond to the Lord's sacrificial love with gratitude and a trusting faith. From the Gospel, Jesus tells us that he suffered and died for us because of the depth of God's love for us. He is indeed a Good Shepherd who cares for his flock vigilantly. This is the work of God that we believe in the one sent. As we continue to bask in the joy of the Resurrection, the Easter readings strive to move us towards living that joy even within the reality of a troubled, fallen world.

Jesus acclaims, "Whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst." Jesus promises that if we place our trust in him, he will provide nourishment to fulfill our spiritual hunger.

We are all the Lord's instruments, trusting in his plan with a view of carrying out God's presence. Through the eyes of Jesus, let us also see God's presence by turning to the Lord with faith. The Lord wills our salvation and desires us to live with God forever. To do this our Father God has a specific plan for each one of us, and his plan in turn leads to eternal life. The early Church saw God's presence everywhere - through physical healing, vibrant community life, and testimony amidst persecution. Like those early Christians, may we return to the Lord with eyes that seek God's plan at work all round us.
