

#### Meditation on The Most Holy Trinity Year B

Through our baptism, we receive our identity as children of God with Christ. The mystery of the Holy Trinity is essential to our Christian faith and a fundamental teaching of the Church. We are baptized in the name of the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit, therein receiving the spirit that enables us to call God our Father. Moreover, our identity as sons and daughters of God calls us also to share in the Son's suffering, so that we might also share in his glory.

There is a continuum between the OT and the NT reminding us that as the people of God, we are a trinitarian community of believers. For example, in the OT Moses tells the people that the action of God on their behalf clearly shows that He is Lord of heaven and earth. The Apostle Paul builds on this belief about the activity of God by saying that those who have remained a spirit of adoption are called to be children of God and joint heirs with Christ.

In today's gospel reading, Jesus tells the 11th disciples to make disciples of all nations, baptizing them with the trinitarian formula and in the name of our Triune God, Father, Son, and Spirit. Embedded in the Trinity is the mystery of God himself, a mystery that enlightens us to contemplate our faith. God reveals through Trinity who he really is - a communion of love between the Father, Son, and Spirit. Finally, the Trinity reveals the love of God and that life in which we are called to have a share. The Trinity is a trajectory revealed to us by God, albeit in mystery, that God is always with us - even until the end of the age.
