

#### Meditation on the 11th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B

The seeds of God's kingdom are indeed planted but not yet fully grown. Jesus uses the images of the sower and the mustard seed to explain the Kingdom of God. Although seemingly small or insignificant the mustard seed, the smallest of all seeds demonstrates that great things can happen through the work of God. Nevertheless, the kingdom must grow and flourish to become like Ezekiel's lofty cedar tree. In the ancient world and in our present-day Holy Land, the cedar tree is very much admired and appreciated because it has the multipurpose of producing the fruits of the kingdom. All our efforts in building the kingdom, even if they seem small, will be blessed by God. Ezekiel, the priest-prophet, speaks on behalf of the Lord God, saying that he will plant a majestic cedar on the mountain of Israel.

The two images of the tiny mustard seed planted by the sewer is a reinforcement of the image proclaimed by Isaiah of the small seedling becoming a mighty cedar tree. These are indeed images of hope in the Kingdom of God. As Ezekiel, on behalf of God, plants the majestic cedar on the high mountain, this becomes a symbol of Israel's faith to grow and believe. The symbol also reinforces this idea by enjoining us to walk by faith not by sight and with patience for the arrival of the day when we appear before the judgment seat of Christ. Moreover, Jesus likens the Kingdom of God to one who scatters seeds and harvests them when it is right.

Let us compare the Kingdom of God to a tiny mustard seed and, a cedar tree seedling that grows into something much larger. Therefore, all our efforts in building the Kingdom of God, even if they seem, small, will be blessed by God.
