Meditation on the 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time
Year B

God's love for us is more powerful than any challenge we might face in this life. Today's readings reflect God's profound love for us even in the midst of turbulent times. Often when our faith is challenged, we are distraught. It is then we must trust that God is with us and have complete trust that his love is more powerful than the storms of our lives.

In the first reading, the Lord speaks to Job out of the whirlwind of the storm. The Lord reminds Job of the divine power that heretofore protected him. In the second reading, the Apostle Paul reflects that the love of Christ has brought about in him a new way of life. "To live is Christ, to die as gain." (Phil 1:21)

In the gospel for today, a violent storm comes up as Jesus and his disciples are in a boat. Jesus calms the storm and then asks the frightened disciples, "Do you not yet have faith?"

This upcoming week celebrates the nativity of St John the Baptist and it is a Solemnity. Each one of us belongs to God, therefore we place great emphasis on a name by giving the long-awaited and joyful anticipated birth of a child John the Baptist enters into the world as a forerunner of Jesus Christ. And the infant is named John. Zachariah, John's father is delivered from his muteness, and he humbly accepts that his son John truly belongs to God. From the ancient Hebrew the name John means, "God is gracious." As was the case of John the Baptist, there is blessing and opportunity awaiting us when we too are called by name to accept the Son of God.
