The General Chapter of The Barnabites

In July the Congregation of the Barnabites will hold its 138th General Chapter in Warsaw, Poland.

Chapters are defined by the Constitutions as meeting of the confreres to stimulate the common life of a community and they can be decision-making, electoral or spiritual in character. They can also serve to bring together confreres of the same or different communities to share ideas and experiences, to suggest projects etc... and they can be at the general, provincial or local level.

The general chapter is the assembly of the representatives of all the confreres. It is the source of law in the Congregation and has supreme power. Ordinarily, the general chapter takes place every six years, and extraordinarily, when serious cause makes it advisable.

The principal duties of the chapter are:

- to study the most important problems of the Congregation and to issue appropriate deliberations;
- to outline general orientative policies;
- to elect the Superior general, the Assistants, and extraordinarily, other Superiors and officials;
- to interpret and update the Constitutions and to approve other norms valid for the whole Congregation;
- to establish, modify, suppress provinces, pro-provinces, central offices, and to issue decrees regarding founding or closing houses.

The general chapter operates in an attitude of listening and of availability to the voice of the Spirit. In this spiritual climate the chapter brings the Congregation to the clearer awareness of its state and of the needs of the times. It urges the Congregation to its best traditions and to a constant renewal, to a generous evangelic service, in a renewed cooperation with the church.

The Superior general, the successor of the Holy Founder, is the supreme moderator of our religious family and the symbol of its unity. He has ordinary jurisdiction over all confreres, the communities and the provinces of Congregation and over its temporal goods; this power is to be exercised within the limits established by the Constitution and by universal law.

The Assistants are the ordinary counsellors of the Superior general; they assist him in the exercise of his functions and share in the responsibility of government.

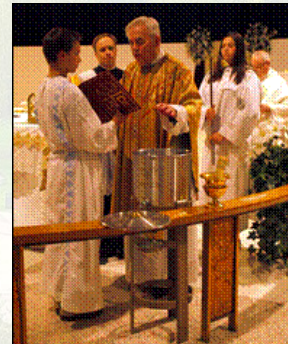
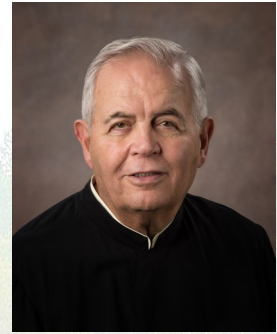
Rev. Julio M. Ciavaglia, CRSP

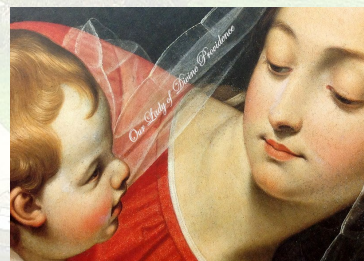

Fr. Albino was born in Tomas Oppus Southern Leyte Philippines. Fr. Albino has a degree in Philosophy at St. Camillus College Seminary, Marikina and a degree in Theology at Divine Word School of Theology, Tagaytay Philippines. Fr. Albino professed his vows as a Clerics Regular of St. Paul (Barnabites) on May 13, 2008. He was ordained February 18, 2014 in St. Anthony Mary Zaccaria Parish in Silangan, San Mateo Rizal in the Diocese of Antipolo. Fr. Albino started serving the Our Lady of the Rosary Parish on March 2015. On Oct. 14, 2023 Fr. Albino was assigned to start serving at the Fatima Shrine. We are truly blessed to have Fr. Albino here at the shrine. Father is also the Vocations Director for North America. Father Albino is also a very active member of Our Lady's Rosary Makers here at the Fatima Shrine, and the acting Chaplin for the Legion of Mary. Fr. 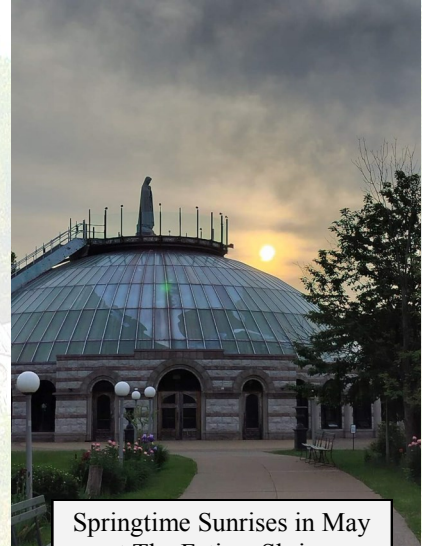

From Fatima:

The 13th of May, 1917

We stopped, astonished, before the Apparition. We were so close, just a few feet from her, that we were bathed in the light which surrounded her, or rather, which radiated from her. Then Our Lady spoke to us:

“Do not be afraid. I will do you no harm.”

“Where are you from?”

“I am from Heaven.”

“What do you want of me?”

“I have come to ask you to come here for six months in succession, on the 13th day, at this hour. Later on, I will tell you who I am and what I want. Afterwards, I will return here yet a seventh time.”

“Shall I go to Heaven too?”

“Yes, you will.”

“And Jacinta?”

“She will go also.”

“And Francisco?”

“He will go there too, but he must say many Rosaries.”

Other Words Spoken by Our Lady that day:

“Are you willing to offer yourselves to God and bear all the sufferings he wills to send you, as an act of reparation for the sins by which He is offended, and of supplication for the conversion of sinners?” they replied, “Yes, we are willing.”

“Pray the Rosary every day, in order to obtain peace for the world, and the end of the war.”

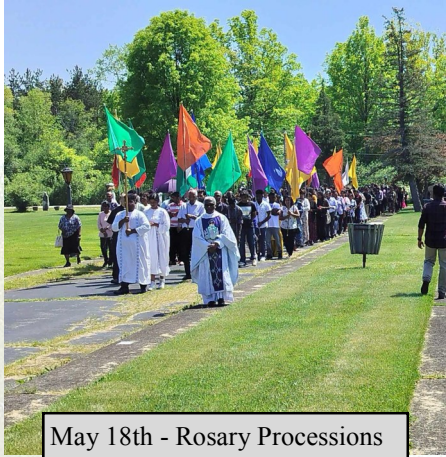
