

Meditation for the 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B

We are called to share our faith both near and far. In today's gospel, Jesus proclaims the Good News, the gospel, in his native place. His message was not well received. There were a few who came to believe, but his message was not well received by many. The people of Christ's "native people" cannot see how his humble origins are capable of his wisdom and mighty deeds.

The Lord sends the prophet Ezekiel to speak his words to the Israelites who have rebelled against God. The Apostle Paul shares with the Corinthians how God's power exemplifies faith through his own personal weakness. He says, "Power is made perfect in weakness". And so it must also be with us the faithful.

The unashamed acknowledgment of our weakness opens us up to welcome Christ eagerly whose grace is then sufficient for us. Sometimes our efforts bare little fruit, but at other times, by God's grace, we just may come by faith to that possibility thereby encouraging us to persevere in all our faith-filled endeavors. In other words, in our weakness let us welcome Christ whose grace is sufficient for us all.
