### Meditation for the 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B



The focus of the readings for today enjoins us to adhere to the words of Jesus - "If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all." Moreover, Jesus' words in today's gospel about being a servant to everyone is a reminder that the ways of the Lord are manifestly not the ways of the world. If we wish to be the disciples of Christ, we must have the courage to seek to understand God's ways and strive to love him with all our hearts. This requires that also we love one another with humility and compassion.

The author of wisdom, today's first reading recounts how the wicked plot to test the just even to the point of torture and death. In the second reading James, the author contrasts those human passions that lead to conflicts and to other problems in the community. Jesus teaches his disciples and us about his upcoming fate and the importance of being a servant to all. In other words, the Son of Man is to be handed over...

Even though the crucifixion was preordained, let us not condemn the crucified one to a shameful death; for indeed the Providence of God will take care of him. In other words, our redemption as the first fruit of righteousness is sown in peace for those who cultivate peace.
