

A Meditation for the 34th Sunday of Ordinary Time Year B (The Solemnity of our Lord Jesus, King of the Universe)

Jesus Christ is King and Lord of all both now and forever. The reading from the prophet Daniel and the book of Revelation share a futuristic, apocalyptic vision of the Son of Man coming out of the clouds to rule over all peoples. Today's powerful reading from John's gospel, on the other hand, declares that Jesus Christ is already King. His everlasting authority comes directly from God. For all of us as disciples eternal life is already possible for those who listen to his voice.

"Worthy is the lamb who was slain to receive power and divinity and wisdom and strength and honor, to him belong glory and power forever and ever." (Rev 5:12; 1,6)

By acknowledging Jesus of Nazareth with the title King and by calling ourselves Christians, we identify ourselves as followers of the King. God did not intend Israel to be a kingdom. The kingdom was a result of Israel's rebellion against God. The law, that is the Torah, was to be Israel's King. Ironically through the Law, God himself yielded to Israel's obstanancy and created a kingdom out of the 12 tribes of Israel.

History acknowledges that through the passage of time God sent his Son whom we now acknowledge as the King of righteousness. The Son who entered humanity is now acknowledged as our redeemer King.

Christ the King has become for us our supreme ruler. God has many ways of finding us, even by turning our wrong ways into right ways. In other words God who didn't want to give the People of God a King finally gives us Christ the King of Kings.

The Solemnity of Christ the King is therefore not a feast of those who are being subjected, but rather a joyful celebration of those who in Christ the King are in the hands of the one who delivers through scripture and tradition and writes straight with crooked lines.

As we celebrate Christ the King we recognize that through his kingship, "His dominion is an everlasting dominion." His kingship will not be destroyed or even taken away. We believe that Jesus Christ is the ruler of the kings of the earth and by faith he's transformed us into a kingdom of priests for his God and Father.

In his lifetime Jesus was challenged in being perceived as an earthly king. But he resolutely makes the claim that he was born and came into the world to testify to the truth. "And everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice."

I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, thus says the Lord our God, the one who is and who was and who is to come, the almighty Christ our King.
