A Spiritual Meditation for the 6th Sunday of Easter - Year C

The key to unity and peace, Jesus can break through every dividing wall. When our hearts become the eternal dwelling place of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the indwelling home of the Holy Spirit is at peace. Think of this spiritual reality the next time you are at Mass. Think of the people around you who are suffering from divisions - families who are hurting, marriages that are crumbling, those cliques or realities that threaten unity. Think about your own heart as well. Is there someone present at Mass with whom you need to be reconciled? Someone you avoid or resent or bear envy? If so, offered that relational problem to the Lord, and ask God to help you to heal.

Then, as you are offered communion be predisposed to healing, and remember that Jesus is offering his own body and blood to everyone present - regardless of their background or challenges, or struggles. Christ loves everyone equally, and he longs for everyone to take another step toward healing and reconciliation. Furthermore, what do you hear Jesus saying to you personally?

Do you hear Jesus saying, asking you to reach out to anyone in particular? What do you want to say to Jesus? What do you want to say to that other person? Remember, the mass is a prayer-dialogue. Moreover, your prayer is not prayed in a vacuum - you are never alone. As a prayer for unity and reconciliation, the Mass is nuanced by the hovering power of the Holy Spirit and contextualized by God's desire to be with you. Prayer places us in the sacred presence. God speaks, we need each other - listen, learn, be set free to love, as God loves, unconditionally. The mystery of faith reaches out to us as we pray the Mass with mind and voice. Pray to be lifted up, each time. The resurrection is **now**. Thus, we explore the promise, pilgrims united. And we don't have to wait until we die to experience the power of Jesus' resurrection.
