A Spiritual Meditation for the 7th Sunday of Easter - Year C

During the last supper, Jesus prayed for us to be one with him and with his Father, and with each other. Later, when Jesus with his disciples retreated to a nearby garden, he prayed specifically for those disciples who would believe in him in future generations - that they be united to him and to each other. Jesus makes unity possible by the events that we celebrate during the 50 days of the Easter season. And so as the Easter season is fast drawing to a close, we do well to remember Jesus by his passion, death, and resurrection - and by the sending of the gift of the Holy Spirit - that through our remembrance of the Christ-event we are united as members of the Church as adopted children of God.

In the first reading, Stephen, a young deacon, looks up intently to heaven and sees Jesus, the one who makes unity desired by Jesus Christ himself, that all may be one, a prayerful plea that the Church, the Assembly of God, will always strive to be a unified witness to the Resurrection. Moreover, Saul - soon to be Paul - was a witness to Stephen being stoned to death. And shortly after, Saul experienced, as Stephen had, an encounter with the Christ, and his life as an apostle was never again the same. As Saul, the Righteous Jew, witnessed Stephen the martyr dying in Christ, so also he became a faithful witness in Christ and to the efficacy of the Crucified One.

Furthermore, it is Jesus sending his testimony that he is coming soon, so that all may be one. Jesus prays that all may be one as he and the Father are one in order that all may know the Father through the Son.

On the island of Patmos as a prisoner, the disciple John heard a voice saying, "Behold I am coming soon. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end. Our simplest prayer on unity can be, Amen, Come, Lord Jesus. Let us pray, resonating with words of Jesus in the garden that all may be brought to perfection as one... beholding "the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God."
