A Spiritual Meditation for Pentecost Sunday - Year C

Ten days ago, we celebrated the Ascension of Jesus into heaven, where he sits at the right hand of the Father. Today, let us ask the Lord to give us hearts that are open and docile, and faithful to the work of the Spirit. The Holy Spirit transformed the disciples into courageous witnesses of the Resurrection of our Lord. It is the same spirit that we have received at our baptism and whose fullness is given to us at our confirmation so that, like those first disciples, we may, in this time of the Spirit, might build up the Church, the people of God.

With the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost, the 50th day of Easter, Christ's Paschal Mystery is brought to completion. The Holy Spirit by its very presence within us, causes us to be true Christians and other Christs. The death of Jesus frees us from being "debtors to the flesh", while it also strengthens us with his gifts. The Spirit reconciles us to God, therein bringing us to God and giving us the status of adopted daughters and sons.

St. Thomas Aquinas powerfully explained that the Holy Spirit interiorly perfects our spirit, communicating to it a new dynamism so that it refrains from evil, not simply out of fear of punishment, but for love. The first gift of love is love itself. All other gifts emanate from this supreme gift, as if from their sources.

The Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples, and they began to speak. "The spirit of the Lord has filled the whole world, and that which contains all things understands what is said" (Wisdom 1,7). And again, "the love of God has been poured into our hearts through the Spirit of God dwelling within us" (Rom 5,8; 8,11).

Submitting to the power of the Holy Spirit can be challenging, and we can be tempted to resist. Nevertheless, let us ask the Lord to give us hearts that are calmly open to the work of the Spirit in us. Then, may love be the energizing principle that drives us and animates us. To the members of the body of Christ, love empowers us to forgive and be forgiven.
