## A Spiritual Meditation for the 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year C

With the arrival of July, the Sunday lectionary readings resume ordinary time. And so, the liturgies of Year C will focus on Jesus as a man of action and also a man of prayer. To illustrate this, the first reading is an ancient hymn that the Lord would shower upon Jerusalem. Moreover, the Lord's power shall be known through comforting his beloved people. Although there is not an immediate connection between the Isaiah reading and the Gospel, blessings are bestowed upon the disciples as they are sent out two by two to preach peace, cure the sick, and survive among the wolves in the real world.

The disciples, 72 in number rejoice at their found power. Nevertheless, Jesus wants them to realize the greater and essential dignity that he has given them - "Rejoice because your names are written in heaven."

In the second reading, the Apostle Paul further develops the theme of grace-filled rejoicing. In other words, if we share in Christ's suffering, so also will we share in his joy. By the power of the Cross do we boast because at our baptism we were set apart to share in Christ's mission. It is baptism and not circumcision that sets us apart, marked with the indelible seal that in Christ's mission, we also are part of his suffering. We now have hope that we who have died with Christ, will also rise to live with him in the new Jerusalem. Let all the earth rejoice and cry out to God with joyful thanksgiving.

May we boast in the Cross of our Lord in order to be a new creation - united to rejoice with Jerusalem and comforted in the arms of our loving God and in his Christ with whom we are bonded with an indelible baptismal seal that sets us apart to share in the mission of Christ - to proclaim the Kingdom of God.
