### A Spiritual Meditation for the 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year C

The law that God gave to Israel was a wonderful gift. Many of the pagan nations lived in fear, for they did not know what their gods wanted. But the Lord God of Israel gave his chosen people the law, the Torah to guide them to walk in the path of righteousness. Therefore, the psalmist is correct to say, "Turn to the Lord in your need, and you will live. The law of the Lord is perfect giving to those who believe spirit and life."

The second reading is a powerfully beautiful hymn that speaks about the cosmic Christ. The early church struggled to develop reasonably clear concepts that would explain who Jesus was - the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. The hymn also presents Jesus as the wisdom of God which is clearly in the OT an attribute of God, as head of the church, the firstborn of the dead. Jesus brings about our justification with God through his death and resurrection.

However, the word of God and its preeminence is not a simple utterance. Rather, it is a communication of life and love and filled with the spirit of everlasting life. The Gospel Law of love challenges us to the question: Who is my neighbor? According to Luke's good news, we are to love our neighbor and all people. And so, the question telescopes with profound implications for how we are to regard others in the world.

Jesus gives an extreme answer and challenge to his listeners. His parable speaks of a good Samaritan. And herein lies the sting. Jesus exemplifies the Samaritan, someone worthy of imitation, and the Jews hated the Samaritans. In other words, the situation is comparable to our being told that a terrorist is the hero of the story - and a worthy example of what a Christian should be.

It would seem then that Luke by the storytelling of Jesus' parable that sometimes we have to be shocked in order to break through the tendency to hear but not to truly listen. As we hear the parable of the Good Samaritan, we are challenged by Christ to treat all with respect and love, especially the poor, the dispossessed, and the most vulnerable. Then and only then are we able to grasp the answer, "And who is my neighbor?"
