A Spiritual Meditation for the 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year C

Jesus, while he was on earth, was a countercultural historical person. Subsequently, as followers of Christ, we also do not always fall in line with the ways of the world. In the Gospel, Jesus warns us that following Him will not always bring peace into our lives. In fact, if we follow him and his ways, we might encounter division - even within our own family.

In the prophetic tradition of those chosen to be speakers for God, Jesus prophetically spoke and taught his followers a new way of living which is often contrary to the "ways of the world." Yet with God's grace, we can strive to be faithful to this call to give witness to the ways of God, all the way to the cross.

However, we often feel that if we do what is right, then God should make everything work out for our own benefit. Then, when things fall apart, we feel as if God is not upholding his part of the problem. Nevertheless, Jesus never promised his disciples wealth or worldly success. But he did promise them a cross through which they could express their love and trust of him.

The prophet Jeremiah was punished by his adversaries because he spoke out against hypocrisy. Similarly, Christ came - and still comes - to divide us from whatever keeps us from Him. By authentically following Jesus, He rids US of every burden and sin and calls us to cling to him. When we keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, we are waiting for him, and trusting that he will put a new perspective of praise and thanksgiving into our mouths and ears.

Let us persevere in running the race that lies before us. Jesus endured the cross... for the sake of the joy that lay before him. Jesus longs to set the world on fire through the baptism of his suffering and death. Moreover, Jesus emphasizes that he doesn't bring peace as a priority but the division that rises up by the promotion of "special agendas." By acknowledging that the world, as a global village, is fraught with division, life becomes a showdown between the gospel of truth that unites and the privatizing of life's insidious division.

With God's grace we can be faithful to the hopeful call to unite in the ways of God. Our faith need not be a division of us versus them; rather, the love of God calls for a unity of love that obviates any sense of division, as it transforms us into the Shalom of God, whose peace surpasses all human understanding.
