A Spiritual Meditation for the 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year C

Cleverness was considered to be an essential virtue in the Hellenistic world during the time of Jesus. Then as now one had to know how to navigate through difficult situations. Jesus, in fact, bemoans the fact that even though we are clever in worldly things, we do not seem to be able to use that talent in spiritual things. The rich man had to learn that everything we have is given to us in trust so that it might be used for the good of all.

Pope St. John XXIII was once asked why there are so many atheists in the world. His answer was that it was due to our own fault. We often fail to be what we say we are. Similarly, Gandhi was asked what he thought of the Gospels. He said that they were wonderful, and that we all should try to live by them.

If we try to live God's generous love to the fullest, then we will share in God's glory when we meet him on the Day of the Lord. Moreover, Blessed is the one who secures justice for the oppressed and gives food to the hungry. Sacred Scripture teaches us to pursue righteousness, not selfishness. When we suffer, as Lazarus, it follows that we grow in humility and empathy toward others.

The Prophet Amos, a man who sought the welfare of the poor and disenfranchised, was vicious, even vitriolic, in his attacks on the decadence of the rich, especially of the complacent, self-serving Israelites. Moreover, Paul charges Timothy (the second reading) to live up to his call as a man of God, "until the appearance of our Lord Jesus Christ." When we do not share the resources of our wealth and prosperity, here on earth, we ignore the opportunity to alleviate suffering. The rich man during his earthly life ignored Lazarus' suffering, yet in death their situations were reversed. Although not a good in itself, suffering can change our hearts, move us to repentance, and return us to the mercy of God. Be generous now. The measure of any society is how well it treats those who are powerless. The measure for how much we get as Christians is how much we act as Christ would have acted.
