### A Spiritual Meditation for the 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year C

The month of October is finally here. Autumn has arrived. The days are shorter, the nights cooler. Before we realize it, ordinary time will come to an end for this liturgical year. Moreover, the Scripture readings direct our attention to faith as a gift that demands a response. Faith is a gift that God gives freely, but this gift can be rejected by us and then lost through our failure to nurture and grow in it.

Today's scriptures encourage us to persevere in the faith until the end, remembering that God did not give us the Spirit of cowardice but rather of power and love and self-control. With the gift of faith and the help of the Holy Spirit, we can indeed do great things for God.

For example, in the first reading, Habakkuk asks angrily how long must he look upon destruction and violence. The Lord responds that the heavenly vision will be fulfilled, and it will not disappoint. In the second reading, the Apostle Paul tells Timothy to stir into flame the gift of God that he has received and to bear his share of hardship for the gospel with the help of the Holy Spirit. Poignantly, in the gospel, the 12 apostles asked Jesus to increase their faith.

A faith that is proactive and hopeful is fostered through a Christ-centered friendship and fraternal love. This fostering, in turn, helps us to discover who we are called to be. As an antidote to isolation, our faith gives us an interactive friendship and personal relationship with God and others, and subsequently gives us the chance to live that life of courage to be part of something much greater than ourselves - and to do that while connecting with like-minded others.

Moreover, we can never approach the altar without desiring to bring others with us to know the love that we know - and to share it. Faith manifested in a Eucharistic renewal is not a matter of promoting a private devotion or belief in an abstraction. Rather, through the Mass, we are all invited to a communion with the living God and called into that same communion with others. The crucified one, by offering himself, is the risen one who delivers himself into our hands, allowing us to realize that together we are all partakers of God in the fellowship of love. By a vibrant faith, we cry out together: Jesus, joy of our desiring.
