### **A Spiritual Meditation for the 28th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year C**

Throughout this month of October, Sacred Scripture offers inspirational antidotes that indicate the proper dispositions of faith for life's journey. Moreover, opening up the word reveals in a timely way a challenge, namely, the power of persistence. And yet with the perceiving power of faith, enough really **is** enough.

Enough is enough is often a comment of lament in response to frustrations experienced daily. But for followers of Jesus, believing, having faith, really isn't enough. Thus, with perseverance, a gospel faith leads to the virtue of hope. Nevertheless, how easily we simply acquiesce to life, and if what we do seems to work for enough, we become content in the "status quo". However, pondering scripture, to live in faith, we can seek and find the greater good beyond mere satisfaction. In other words, by faith in the potential of being a faithful one, we get more than just enough.

By cultivating a greater sense of gratitude, life offers hope, kindness beyond kinship, salvation beyond health, life beyond death - and the bounteous grace of God, which offers so much more than what simply suffices. Faith gives that and presupposes us to be grateful.

The Apostle Paul urges us to persevere even in the face of challenge: "if we persevere, we shall also reign with him." For those in extremely difficult circumstances, by faith all we can find hope in God in the face of stress - and desperate measures. For example, the 10 lepers and Naaman are completely healed by the transformative power of faith and the abundant grace of God.

Today's gospel reading demonstrates the gracious power of Jesus. 10 Lepers encounter Jesus. They are estranged from society because of their physical condition. They "meet" Jesus and are healed. Cautiously, they depart quietly to show themselves to the rabbi. But one returns, a Samaritan to give thanks to Jesus. For, indeed, his faith saved him. Clearly, with faith, the 10th leper came to realize that by faith, we get more than enough. Jesus teaches all of us, his disciples, to recognize the saving power of faith.
