A Spiritual Meditation for the 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year C

No one completes life's journey with ease. Opening the Word of God, scripture reveals how faith emboldened believers to undertake challenges with courage and to overcome obstacles with conviction. Sacred scripture is useful in faith formation, and prayer in effective intercession, so that with faith we can be bold as we experience the living God, Yahweh, beside us in all ways, at all times.

The Bible is the story of God's action in history. Furthermore, salvation history invites us to be attentive to preaching, i.e. the kerygma, especially whether it is convenient or inconvenient. For indeed, the Christian community, faith is revealed, proclaimed, and sustained through hearing and listening to the homily focused as it is upon sacred scripture.

Believing that the Lord God intervenes on behalf of his people - as he has done definitively in the person and work of Jesus Christ - who also provides the conviction necessary to face any challenge in this world. Simply, boldly preached, listening to the homily thoughtfully is not a "snooze time" in the liturgy. Rather, It is a source of courage and conviction.

The important question is this: as those who are attentive at Mass, how attentive are we to what is preached at homily time? Do we sense that urgency of the message that the Kingdom of God is at hand here and now. And you and I are vital participants in God's plan. Moreover, it is right and good to remember that we are God's people who reside in God's kingdom. Let us be attentive and pray for the grace of joyful hope even in the midst of worldly sorrows.

The Apostle Paul resonates with the challenge of sorrowful estrangement. He is thankful for Luke's presence in the jailer's cell, supporting him, while so many others have abandoned him. Like Paul, with faith be bold in the gospel. Realistically we know that the harvest is abundant, even though the laborers are few. Yet also know that by faith, God attends to all our needs, and in Christ we are encouraged to proclaim boldly with charitable love the coming of the Kingdom of Heaven.
