### A Spiritual Meditation for the 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year C

Humility before the Lord is its own righteousness. On our life-journey, many of us seek to forge our own paths of success. Often, however, the word of God points instead to a humble dependence as the proper behavioral disposition for people of faith. In the spiritual life, it is tempting to look upon others' motivations and behaviors and then to comfort ourselves with the thought that we are, at least, not like them. Yet the Lord reminds us that by a sincere observation, we recognize that the poor, by faith, have more. Thus, we've come to realize that spiritual poverty is a beneficial dependence on the grace of God. And so, prayer is a powerful refuge from the anxieties of the world - and hope is predicated by the foundation of divine mercy.

As we journey through life, the good news finds us in the faith that accompanies us. Through righteousness, when we cultivate sincerity proper to humanity, we can also be confident that the Lord hears the cry of our prayer, the cry of the poor, and in sequence gives us the strength to continue on our journey to salvation.

It is such a boon to follow the life of Paul the Apostle. As a righteous Jew, a Pharisee, Paul was convinced of our total reliance on God's mercy. He was self-righteously preoccupied with a pious zeal for the efficacy of the law, until he was converted to the power of Christ and His Cross. Now nearing the end of his life, he expresses a total trust in the Lord's help and the eternal reward of the gospel. The faith that Paul proclaimed steadily to the gentiles, bolsters him with hope. Take heart, he says, "There is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus." By feeling deserted by others in his time of need, he has come to depend entirely on the Lord, who stood by him and has given him strength. As his life is coming to an end, he is confident that by his poverty, faith gives him so much more. He now has total confidence of being safely close to God's heavenly kingdom. Blessed are the poor in spirit, for with faith they have more. Indeed, in Christ, we are called by name; for in our votive offering given in the spirit of poverty, we are potential candidates for the heavenly kingdom, where the poor exist favorably with God's blessing.
