### A Spiritual Meditation for All Souls Day, the Commemoration of all The Faithful Departed - Year C

It is now the month of November, a timely reminder of transition from autumn's warmth to winter's approach, a time to reflect on themes of change, gratitude, and the quiet beauty of the world preparing for rest. How sad would November be if we had no hopeful memory, if we had no anticipation of spring. So let us remember to allow this month be a reminder that even in this season of change, there is still beauty and strength to be found. As November arrives, the days are shorter, and autumn is a time of change and preparation; thus how lovely leaves grow old, and yet are so full of color is their last days.

Yesterday's feast offers us an excellent opportunity to consider those people in our lives who have taught us the meaning of sanctity. As we acknowledge all the saints, let us celebrate everyone who lovingly responds to God's call. This is why the Apostle Paul calls all of the Christian communities "saints", for he realized that there are many saints all around us.

Today's commemoration, because it occurs on a Sunday, is also a Solemnity. Thus, "the souls of the just are in the hand of God... their hope is full of immortality." "Hope does not disappoint because the love of God has been poured out into our hearts." And not only that,

We also boast of God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation. (cf Romans 5)

Therefore, the double celebration of November 1 and 2 are a faith-filled acknowledgment that Jesus is the source of eternal life for all those who believe in him. God loves us and has chosen us to share eternal life. We are entrusted into Jesus' hands. We are the saints, who remember the faithful departed.

By the power of predestination to salvation, we do not abdicate our freedom. Rather, we are invited to share in God's glory.

There are two forms of eternal life so clearly demonstrated in today's gospel. The first is the life that we are already experiencing as soon as we accept Jesus into our lives. The second is the eternal life that we will experience when we rise from the dead (cf John 6,40)

If, then, we have died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him. (cf Romans 6)

Thus, let us continue to live as if we are dead to sin and alive in the power of Christ, the Crucified Lord, the Risen One.
