A Spiritual Meditation For The Baptism of the Lord (1st Sunday in Ordinary Time) - Year A

The first reading from Isaiah 42, is the first of four hymns from the prophet Isaiah that speak of a mysterious figure called the Suffering Servant YHWH (The Lord). This image is scattered throughout the second part of Isaiah (42-55). In this important leitmotif, we hear the recurring hymn that the Servant is a chosen one of God. In fact, he is called "beloved" - even as Jesus is called beloved at his Baptism.

The Servant is a gentle figure who brings justice to the entire world, not only the people of Israel. Throughout the OT, it is never quite clear who the servant is supposed to be - Israel the nation or one of the prophets. One thing is clear, Jesus himself applied this image to this mission, especially his suffering and death on the cross.

Today, as we celebrate the Baptism of Jesus, we are recalling to mind that Jesus is not simply a person who is being baptized by John the Baptist in the Jordan River. He is also the only begotten Son of God who sanctifies the water of conversion and offers us an invitation into the sacred participation into the life of the Trinity.

Our baptism is a rite of passage wherein God breathes His Spirit into our hearts so that we might know that we are his beloved children, hence, heirs of the Suffering Servant, who in Christ must fulfill everything that was expected of him. Remember, we are God's children by virtue of our baptism.
