A Spiritual Meditation for the 4th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year A

The prophet Zephaniah, today's first reading addresses those who are humble. This fits well with the Beatitude that speaks of those who are poor in spirit. Moreover, it is good to know that we are not in charge. Therefore, it is also good to know that we do not know or understand everything, for God's ways are often mysterious but also knowable. And so, when we empty ourselves of our pride and arrogance, we also prepare a place for God's sacred heart to dwell in us.

The Beatitudes, those blessed, remind us of the fact that we most often meet God not in moments of triumph, but rather in our brokenness and need. It is in these humble moments that we are most ready to let God fill the void in our hearts.

As Americans and Canadians, and all who visit the shrine, some of us measure our success by how much we produce every moment of the day. We expect ourselves to be perfect, viewing goals that should always be kept me mind but perhaps never actually are realized. Holiness lies not so much in being perfect as in simply trying to do our best. We are all just works in progress. God knows this and only expects us to do what we can - to be bolstered by the Lord's abounding grace. This should not be an excuse for complacency; but it is a consolation in our life - journey.

The prophecy of Zephaniah speaks about the judgment that will come upon the earth. He proclaims the judgment as the Day of the Lord - a day which will be a day of terror and rage. But God also acknowledges that a remnant of faithful ones will escape judgment through the omnipresence of the protective power of grace - to be the remnant of people who remain faithful to the call of the Lord - both a "red" and "white" martyrdom - through the shedding of blood or an endurance of the manageable principles of everyday life. Let the faithful remnant rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in heaven.
