### A Spiritual Meditation for the 6th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year A

The first reading from the OT book of Sirach addresses the choice between good and evil. "If you choose, you can keep the commandments, they will save you." The choice, however, is not only about choosing. It is actually a choice between life and death. Throughout history, it has been difficult to understand the importance of the Law of the Jewish people. For they believe that they have received the Torah through a special revelation, an intervention into the human life by God. "Blessed are they who follow the law of the Lord."

Complete adherence to the Law - makes the Jews different from all other nations on earth. Historically, nations did not know how to please their gods but the people of God = the faithful remnant of Israel did. Moreover, The Israelites/Jewish people did not view the law as an obligation; rather they thought of it as a gift. And in it they found life and hope.

Nevertheless, a radical belief in the absolute obedience to the law can be a double-edged sword. This can happen if we follow the letter of the law and forget the guidelines that the law is meant to be, a protection of the sacred value of life. In other words, we are called to obey the law by observing it as God's providential code of protection.

According to the teachings of Jesus, we are not called to observe the values of the world, but we are called to observe the gospel values predicated by love. The scribes and Pharisees projected a view of the law that tended to be circumspective. Jesus's contention about the law is one of an expansive, practical application.

God predestined the wisdom of the law before the ages for us that we might be glorified by the enlightenment of Moses who delivered the Torah to the people. Jesus proclaimed the Sermon on the Mount as a source of authority - an authority that comes from God alone. Also, Jesus "spins" a new interpretation of the law. The law is absolute because it comes directly from God. He did not presume to be the source of authority for the law - for that authority comes from God alone and is engendered by the transformative power of love. Moreover, Jesus alters the manner by which he avoids the rhetoric of legalism and illumines the clearly spiritual intent behind the legal language. By doing this his intent is to tell the people what the law really means.
