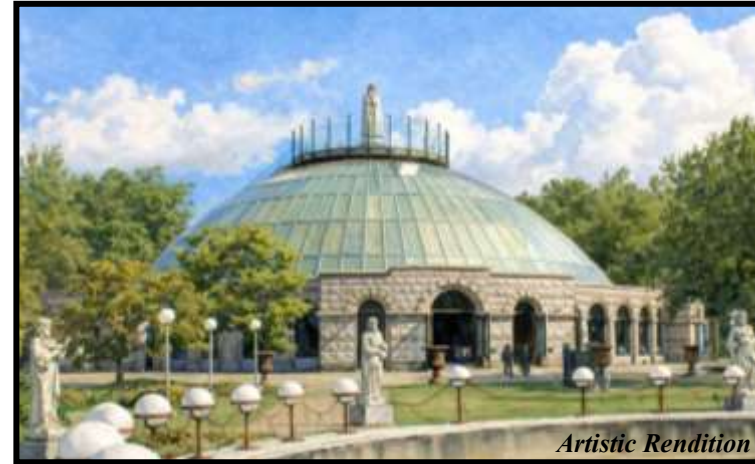

A Spiritual Meditation for the 1st Sunday of Lent - Year A

Today is the first Sunday of Lent. During the next 40 days, Jesus calls us to a conversion of heart. Liturgically, we take a break from ordinary time and focus on Lent as a time to rend our hearts so they are open to God's healing. Our fasting, prayer, and good works are meant to express our mindset a renewal of heart in relation to ourselves, God, and others, yet the wrong or misplaced intentions can render our actions as meaningless or at best perfunctory. And so with the reception of ashes on the first day of opening us up yet again not to receive God's free gift of grace in vain but with a living hope for salvation.

Scripturally, Lent and the celebration of penitential prayer is to begin this holy season by reflecting upon the creation of humanity and also upon the appearance of original sin and the fall and redemption of all humankind. The responsorial psalm is the Lenten recognition of our profound need for compassionate mercy and forgiveness. Furthermore, In the longest of the Apostle Paul's epistles to the Romans, proposes God's plan for humankind and our need for grace as the means to overcome the presence of original sin. In other words sin caused death and that is a just punishment. But Jesus brought life. It is a much greater thing to bring someone back to life than to kill them. Thus, what Jesus did for us fills the believer with awe.

Through one man, Adam, sin entered the world and through sin brought death. Yet through the grace of God came justification - so that as sin came through Adam, by disobedience, So also in Christ all are called to be recipients of a gracious gift of salvation. Thus, to sum up, Paul states as an article of faith: just as through one transgression, condemnation came upon all so also through the obedience of one, the many will be made righteous. However, in God's plan, Satan, evil, does not disappear: Rather Satan does appear with subtle ways and does ensnare us with evil. Beware, then, Satan can tempt us by using our spiritual pride, thereby using a trap to implement virtue as the occasion of judgmental arrogance. By acknowledging our own sinfulness, Satan demonstrates his power. But God's love is greater and much more powerful than Satan's vengeful spiteful hate. The next 40 Days of Lent will be our guide to accept God's love, to rebel against the satanic work of evil and the condemnation of eternal rebellion and to be a single voice that cries out NO to the Evil One and YES to God's mercy.

Turn away from sin and joyfully accept the good news of Jesus Christ. You must take the initiative - God will help... Lent is the opportune moment. Though it is winter now, as the days lengthen, let the warmth of the unconquering sun encourage us to turn away from the coldness of sin and to the warmth of an Easter filled hope.
