A Spiritual Meditation for the 7th Sunday of Easter - Year A

There is a sense of expectation in today's liturgy. We have just celebrated the Ascension, the 40th day of Easter. But we have not yet received the gift of the Holy Spirit. Scripturally, we often have to learn to wait in expectation, for the Lord's timing is not always the same as our timing. Also, when the Apostles returned to Jerusalem, they went to the upper room where they had celebrated the Last Supper. They devoted themselves to prayer. The responsorial Psalm depicts a sense of both a balanced, anticipated hope and desire.

As Jesus prayed for his disciples, cf. the High Priestly Prayer (Jn 17), they are anticipating that as they have been given to Christ by the Father, so now the Son is entrusting them back into the hands of God. Therefore, it is important to remember that faith is ultimately a gracious gift of God to which we respond. And simultaneously, we should realize the apostolic, important, and great responsibility to nurture what God has given.

In his moving deeply felt priestly prayer, Jesus speaks of the world, especially those who are "in the world." They are the ones who rejected Jesus, and continue to do so. And yet, the world is not to be confused with creation. For what God created is good, but what brings humanity down and makes us "worldly" is the snares and wickedness of evil which separates us from God's love.

One of the greatest struggles in the Christian spiritual life is this, how much can we separate ourselves and how much we should participate in the things of the world? Nevertheless, God created the world as good and has given the potential to live in the world and to be circumspect about living of the world. Celebrating life draws us to each other and to God. St. Augustine, a doctor of the Church and holy leader, taught that virtue lies somewhere in the middle. We have to seek balance in the struggle between the sacred and profane. In the daily struggle, we must discern good things and avoid an overly indulgence in evil things.

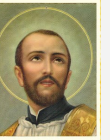

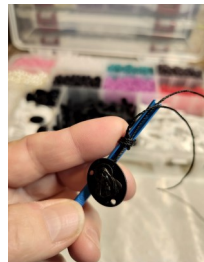
