### A Spiritual Meditation for the 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year A


The first reading is one of the passages known as the Confessions of Jeremiah. The Confessions scattered throughout Jeremiah's prophetic statements express a sincere feeling of despair, betrayal, and frustration. And yet Jeremiah cannot stop proclaiming God's word in spite of his feeling abandoned. On those occasions when Jeremiah tried to keep silent, God's word burned in the very fiber of his being like hot coals.

The more Jeremiah tried to help his Jerusalem friends, they took them as a threat and attacked him. When Jeremiah was threatened with death, he now would have to place his trust in God's providential love.

"Lord, in your great love, answer me" is the Psalmist's lament. Today's responsorial psalm is a lamentation following a typical Hebrew catalogue of difficulties. The first is the difficulties of being faithful. The second element is an appeal to God's mercy. And the third element of the psalm, the hodah, is the petition of deliverance that God might deliver quickly a recovery from sin.

The Apostle in the second reading from Romans continues his attack on sin as a spiritual death and humanity's inability to overcome death as the consequence of sin. However, Paul proclaims a message of hope. In other words, Jesus brought life into the world, and his death on the cross continues to destroy death. Love conquers death, and love overcomes hatred. The gospel proclaims the spirit of truth which comes from God and is transferred to us by our testimony. As in Adam, all die, even so in Christ all have been made alive.

What exactly does God promise us in this life? Is it to be good, financially rich, healthy and happy? Do we seek healing? Yet some of these qualities of life elude us, sometimes even leaving us feeling desperately persecuted. By faith, however, God's promise is always present and that the Lord is and will be there for us. Life's problems never seem to go away here on earth. Just as the Blessed Mother said to Bernadette of Lourdes, only in Heaven will every tear be wiped away and every wound healed. In the bliss of heaven is God's hopeful promise fully realized with happiness.

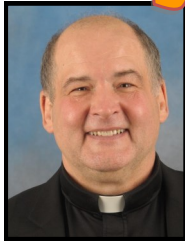

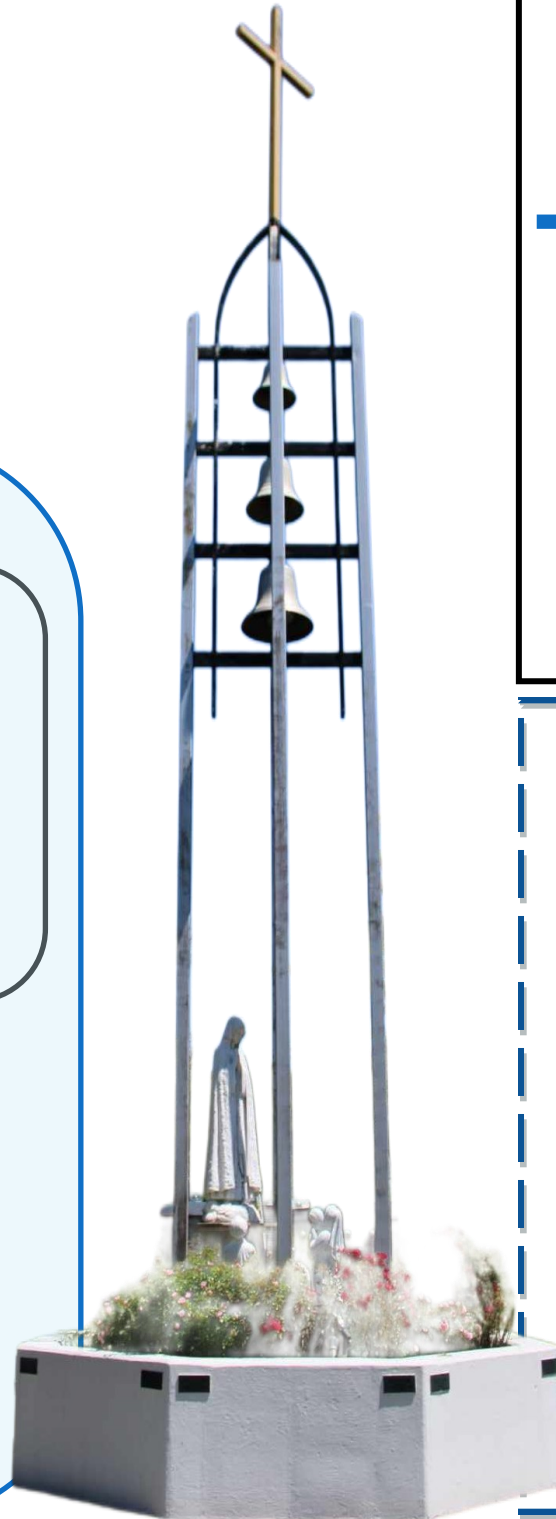
